All courses (Modules) taught at The University of Jordan are free of charge for the exchange students.

Then the course description can be found in the study plan.

If there is (/English) written next to the course name then the course is definitely taught in English (e.g. Principles of Psychology/English). Most of the courses at The School of Business, and most masters courses at the School of International Studies, and the scientific faculties, however, are taught in English.
